

The Graduate Certificate in Public Health at MU: **Now entirely online!**



Why is now the right time to complete your Graduate Certificate in Public Health at MU?

- **Become more skilled.** The Graduate Certificate offers training in foundational areas of public health knowledge, including biostatistics, social and behavioral sciences in public health, environmental health and epidemiology.
- **Become more competitive on the job market.** The aging of the public health workforce will likely outpace budget shortfalls into the future and well-trained public health professionals will be increasingly in demand.
- **Earn acceptance into MU's MPH Program.** Certificate graduates who receive Bs in all twelve credit hours of coursework are automatically recommended for admission into the MPH Program, should they wish to continue their studies.
- **Complete the Certificate online.** With the addition of an online biostatistics course this spring, Certificate students can structure their courses and schedules to complete all 12 credit hours online within one year of beginning the program.
