

Graduate Certificate in Public Health

Students who complete the Graduate Certificate in Public Health in good standing and with a minimum grade of B in each course will be recommended for admission to the Master of Public Health Program should they wish to continue their studies. The course credits earned for the Graduate Certificate may be credited toward the MPH degree.
